

PRIPEO Integration Guide for Next.js / React

Integrate PRIPEO payments in your Next.js application using Server Actions or API Routes.

Before you start

You need the following 4 elements, provided by PRIPEO:

Element	Value	Description
PRIPEO API Key	pk_xxxx...	Unique per merchant
Stripe Public Key	pk_live_IZla...	Shared by all
PayPal Client ID	AVxEYd2f...	Shared by all
API URL	https://pripeo.com/wp-json/pripeo/v1	Base URL

Card payment flow

1. Your Next.js server calls /paiement/creer and receives a client_secret
2. The React component uses @stripe/react-stripe-js to confirm the payment
3. PRIPEO receives the webhook and marks the transaction as successful

Example — Server Action (app/actions/payment.js)

```
'use server'; export async function createPayment(orderData) { const res = await
fetch( 'https://pripeo.com/wp-json/pripeo/v1/paiement/creer', { method: 'POST',
headers: { 'Content-Type': 'application/json', 'X-Pripeo-Key':
process.env.PRIPEO_API_KEY }, body: JSON.stringify({ montant: orderData.amount,
devise: 'eur', reference: `CMD-${orderData.id}`, client_nom:
orderData.customerName, client_email: orderData.customerEmail }) } ); return
res.json(); }
```

PayPal flow

1. Call POST /paypal/creer-commande --> receive order_id + lien_approbation
2. PayPal SDK handles client-side approval
3. Call POST /paypal/capturer with the order_id

Environment variables (.env.local)

```
PRIPEO_API_KEY=pk_your_api_key  
NEXT_PUBLIC_STRIPE_KEY=pk_live_lZlavmyvSB5pbvWUcQP0YSVr  
NEXT_PUBLIC_PAYPAL_CLIENT_ID=AVxEYd2fGLu_NpPQe8...
```

Available API routes

Route	Method	Description
/paiement/creer	POST	Create a card payment
/paypal/creer-commande	POST	Create a PayPal order
/paypal/capturer	POST	Capture PayPal payment
/transaction/{id}	GET	Transaction status
/transactions	GET	List transactions
/webhook/paiement	POST	Confirmation webhook (Stripe)
