

PRIPEO Integration Guide for WooCommerce

Accept card and PayPal payments on your WordPress/WooCommerce store in less than 10 minutes.

Before you start

You need the following 4 elements, provided by PRIPEO:

Element	Value	Description
PRIPEO API Key	pk_xxxx...	Unique per merchant
Stripe Public Key	pk_live_lZla...	Shared by all
PayPal Client ID	AVxEYd2f...	Shared by all
API URL	https://pripeo.com/wp-json/pripeo/v1	Base URL

Step 1 — Install WPCode

In your WordPress dashboard, go to Plugins > Add New, search for WPCode and install it. WPCode lets you add PHP code without modifying theme files.

Step 2 — Create the payment snippet

In WPCode > Snippets > Add New, choose PHP Snippet. Paste the code provided by PRIPEO. At the top of the file, replace the 3 configuration values:

```
define('PRIPEO_MA_CLE_API', 'pk_YOUR_PRIPEO_API_KEY');  
define('PRIPEO_STRIPE_PUB_KEY', 'pk_live_lZlavmyvSB5pbvWUcQP0YSVr');  
define('PRIPEO_PAYPAL_CLIENT_PUB', 'AVxEYd2fGLu_NpPQe8...');  
define('PRIPEO_URL_API', 'https://pripeo.com/wp-json/pripeo/v1');
```

Step 3 — Activate and configure WooCommerce

Activate the snippet. Go to WooCommerce > Settings > Payments. You will see "Card — PRIPEO" and "PayPal — PRIPEO" appear. Enable both payment methods.

Step 4 — Test the payment

Place a test order on your store. Check in PRIPEO Admin > Transactions that the transaction appears with status Successful.

Available API routes

/paiement/creer	POST	Create a card payment
/paypal/creer-commande	POST	Create a PayPal order
/paypal/capturer	POST	Capture PayPal payment
/transaction/{id}	GET	Transaction status
/transactions	GET	List transactions
/webhook/paiement	POST	Confirmation webhook (Stripe)

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
